INSTRUCTIONS CONCERNING CATS AND DOGS ACCOMPANYING REFUGEES FROM UKRAINE



The Swiss Veterinary Service welcomes you. Please read carefully and follow the instructions to protect humans and animals in Switzerland from rabies. Thank you for your cooperation.

STEP 1

If not yet done, please send the application form (page 2) to the address indicated at the bottom of the form, including applicable further documents (proof of microchip, vaccination and antibody titer test). The veterinary service will check the information and contact you.

STEP 2

Until further instructions by the veterinary service, please strictly follow these rules:

- 1. Dogs must always be kept on a short leash and not run free
- 2. Cats must be kept indoors without exception
- 3. Animals must not have any contact with humans or animals other than those living in the same household.
- 4. Do not leave your animal unobserved
- 5. Call the local veterinary service (page 3) immediately, if your animal escapes, acts aggressively, bites or becomes sick



STEP 3

The local veterinary service contacts you and will inform you about necessary further measures. Since Ukraine is not free of rabies, animals with insufficient vaccination may need to be quarantined for a certain period. Depending on the case and individual circumstances, they may be isolated at your place of residence or in an approved facility.

If your animal bites a person/animal, even if the injury is minor, inform the bite victim/owner that your dog or cat comes from a rabies risk country. Any person who is bitten must wash and disinfect the wound, seek medical care immediately and mention that there is a risk of rabies.
